CULES

- 1. The Club shall be called the "REPTON PILGRIMS CRICKET CLUB."
- Full Members of the Club shall be elected from Old Reptonians distinguished for special Cricket merit.
- Honorary Members of the Club may be elected from those who have rendered special service to the School, whether Old Reptonians or not.
- After 1926, no more than twelve full members shall be elected in each
 year, and after that year no one shall be eligible for full membership
 until he shall have played in not less than two matches for the Repton
 Pilgrims Cricket Club.
- Every candidate for membership shall be proposed and seconded by a member, and shall be elected by the Committee, one black ball in three to exclude.
- No member upon any occasion shall play as an opponent to the Repton Pilgrims except with the consent in writing of the President for the time being of the Club.
- 7. Each full member on being elected shall pay an entrance fee to be determined by the committee to the Treasurer. The Treasurer shall give notice to the member of his election and that the entrance fee is due, and if such fee is not paid within three months of such notice the election shall be void, unless a reason for the delay be shown which is satisfactory to the Committee. An annual subscription is also payable as determined by the committee.
- The affairs of the Club shall be managed by a Committee consisting of the Officers of the Club and such a number of members as may from time to time be decided upon at the Annual General Meeting.
- 9. Any member violating the rules of the Club, or guilty of any misconduct, may, on due notice to him given by the Secretary affording him an opportunity to be heard by the Committee in explanation or defence, be expelled by the votes of two-thirds of those present at a Committee meeting. Any member so expelled shall forfeit all claim to the property of the Club, and shall cease to be a member, and shall be incligible for re-election.

The Officers of the Club shall be the President, the Secretary, the Treasurer and Fixture Secretary.

- 11. The Officers and the ordinary members of the Committee shall be elected each year by the Club at the Annual General Meeting, and shall remain in office till the next succeeding Annual General Meeting. Outgoing Officers and the Committee-men shall be eligible for reelection except that the President shall not hold office for more than two years in succession.
- 12. The Annual General Meeting shall be held in the Cricket Pavilion at Repton on Speech Day or prior to the biennial dinner.
- 13. The Committee or Officers may, whenever they think fit, convene a Special General Meeting; and a Special General Meeting shall be convened upon a requisition made to the Secretary in writing, signed by six members not being on the Committee. Any such requisition shall express the object of the Meeting proposed to be called, and upon receipt of such requisition the Secretary shall forthwith proceed to convene a Special General Meeting.
- 14. At least seven days' written notice of every General or Special General Meeting, specifying the place, the day and hour of meeting, and the purpose for which such meeting is called, shall be given to every member, and no business shall be transacted at any Special General Meeting other than that which is specified in such notice or incidental thereto.
- No Repton Pilgrims' match shall be arranged except with the sanction of the Committee.
- A quorum for an Annual or Special General Meeting shall be six, and for a Committee Meeting three.
- 17. The expenses of umpires, scorers, etc., at a match shall be defrayed by the players.
- 18. These Rules shall not be altered except at the General Meeting of the Club, or at a Special General Meeting called for that purpose, and, in any case, only on the members having seven days previous notice in writing of the proposed alterations.
